



REGULATIONS OF THE
2ND INTERNATIONAL MEETING OF SCULPTURE
IN UNTERBÄCH-WALLIS, SWITZERLAND

The international meeting of sculpture will take place between August 26 and September 16, 2018 in the city of Unterbäch, Wallis – Switzerland.

General conditions

The sculptor will be present at least 18 days, including 2 Saturdays and 2 Sundays. Due to safety and nuisance, the working time is only allowed from 7 h 30 to 18 h 30. There must also be at least two persons present at the workplace before any use can be made of machines. No compromise will be allowed on this rule.

Each sculptor is responsible for a personal health and accident insurance.

If the sculptor withdraws his participation, the organization should be informed of this at the latest by 01.06.2018.

Destination

The sculptor is the owner of the work he performed, and sets its price for its sculpture and the price will be signed in a contract.

If a sculpture is sold before a period of two years, a commission of 15 % and the total cost of delivered material (1500 Sfr) on the sale price will be paid to the organization.

If the sculpture is picked up after 2 years of exhibition, material costs and commission for the organization will disappear.



He agrees, however, not to feature before September 1, 2020. For two years the works are exhibited in/near Unterbäch or in a place accessible to the public.

After August 1, 2020, works that were not removed by their makers, will be exhibited indefinitely or will be placed in storage. From that time the organization is no longer responsible for damage or theft.

Accommodations and expenses

The organization provides the participants the opportunity to stay at **Sporthotel Walliserhof (Unterbäch, Switzerland)** for free. If the sculptor request in advance and the sculptor takes a guest with him, the Hotel and the organization will determine the daily price of his guest. This only between August 26th and September 17th 2018.

The organization supplies at the request of the participants free daily breakfast, lunch and diner for the duration of the meeting. Alcoholic drinks and soft drinks will not be offered by the organization!

Because of respect of the cook and hotel staff, there will be no deviation from the agreed hours when food is served. If you are too late (also your visit), the person in question will not be served food. No compromise will be allowed on this rule.

To all participants will be paid travelling expenses. For European citizens/sculptor, the amount the allowance will be calculated individually by the "Routeplanner Michelin". For the oversea sculptors the organization will pay a economy class flight and train ticket.

All other expenses are the responsibility of the participants.

Working tools & Stone



The organization provides a rough block of granite or marble (about 1,2 m²).

The organization supplies electricity, gasoline, compressed air, water and lifting tools necessary for the manipulation of the stone. Air hammers, chisels, compressed air hoses, etc. must be brought by the sculptor. This applies to the sculptors living in Europe.

The organization assumes no responsibility in case of loss, damage or theft of personal tools.

Wage payment

The sculptors will be paid a fee of CHF 50 / for 'every working day' at the end of the meeting and after completion of the work.

Court of justice

When unexpected circumstances occur during the symposium, a solution will be sought in consultation with the sculptors and organization. This democratic agreement will be included in the regulations.

In the event of unauthorized behavior by a sculptor, the organization will decide in consultation whether the sculptor will be discharged from the symposium without any compensation.

For any dispute only the court of the city Leuk in the Swiss canton of Wallis is competent.
